Every Thursday, during the Month of October.

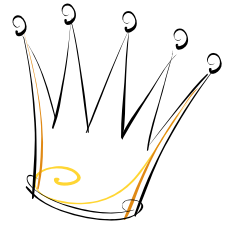

Official Contest Rules:

- ★ You must be 18 or older by contest dates.
- ★ Winner of each preliminary round will advance to the Finals on Friday, October 29, 2010. Advancing contestants must be able to attend the final or her spot will default to the next contestant in queue.
- ★ Friday night Finals will consist of the 4 winners (one from each night), plus a "judge's wild card" selected from the preliminary rounds as a wild card entry and all 5 will compete for the Miss Cooter Crown.
- ★ Each semi-finalist will be required to answer questions.
- ★ Miss Cooter winner will be required to attend Saturday's Cooter Festival during the Cooter Idol Finale and Sunday's Cooterween costume contest.
- ★ Miss Cooter will represent the Great American Cooter Festival as a spokesmodel at various events throughout the year.
- ★ Contestants will be interviewed by a panel of 3 judges and scored on appearance, personality, knowledge & the ability to speak in front of a crowd. All judges' decisions are final.
- ★ Contestants agree to let the Great American Cooter Festival, the City of Inverness and its corresponding websites use the contestant's image at no charge.
- ★ It is our intention to have Miss Cooter represent the festival at other festivals through print, television and other advertising avenues. Should the producers be able to schedule a TV appearance, Miss Cooter should be available to travel to the site of the taping.
