## Rules, Regulations & Information:

- ★ You must be at least 18 years of age by October 24, 2009.
- ★ There is a \$10 non-refundable entry fee.
- ★ Submit application to [cooteridol@cooterfestival.com](mailto:cooteridol@cooterfestival.com) or bring to any Chamber Office.
- ★ Contestants will be selected from the pre-registered applications or at the beginning of each kick-off party.
- ★ Each contestant will be required to sing one song of their choice and one song chosen by the judges (we will provide the back-up music for judge's choice).
- ★ Tie-breakers will be held by each singer performing an additional song.
- ★ Winner of each preliminary round will advance to the finals on Saturday, October 24<sup>th</sup>. Contestant must be available to participate. In the event that the contestant cannot attend, his or her spot will default to the next contestant in queue.
- ★ Saturday will consist of the four winners selected from the preliminary rounds.
- ★ Each semi-finalist will be required to perform a 3 song set during the Saturday performance.
- ★ Cooter Idol winner will be required to attend Sunday's Cooterween.
- ★ This contest is limited to solo performers, no duets or groups.
- ★ Contestant's performance will be scored by a panel of judges. Judges choice is final.
- ★ Contestants will be judged by the following: physical presentation, crowd reaction, choreography/entertainment ability, vocal presentation and overall performance.
- ★ If contestants provide their own music, CD's with vocal tracks are not permitted.
- ★ Contestants agree to let the Great American Cooter Festival, the Citrus County Chamber of Commerce or the City of Inverness and its corresponding website to use the contestant's image at no charge. Contestants further agree, if called upon, to make a personal appearance and represent aforementioned in a respectable manner.
- ★ Choose your song wisely. Avoid songs with big instrumental breaks; the judges want to hear you, not the music.
- ★ If you provide your own CD and it does not play correctly, be prepared to sing your song acappella.
- ★ We do not mind if someone else is doing your song. But, if we see a duplicate, we will give you the option to change your song. However, you do not HAVE to change the song.
- ★ These events are FAMILY oriented events. The use of profanity, vulgar actions, inappropriate clothing, etc. will result in an immediate disqualification. You will immediately be removed from the competition and you will not be issued a refund.
- ★ The Cooter Idol Karaoke Contest is an amateur competition. Contestants who have had a recording contract within the last five years are ineligible.
- ★ Applicants must provide:
  - Completed registration form
  - Name and artist of song to be sung at audition
  - \$10 entry fee payable to the Citrus County Chamber of Commerce
- ★ Contestants may pre-register by submitting the form to [cooteridol@cooterfestival.com](mailto:cooteridol@cooterfestival.com) or by bringing to any Chamber Office. You must attend a kickoff party to participate.

- ★ If registering at a kick-off party, application forms will be provided.
